The Instructional Technology Planning Group is comprised of membership from all areas of the college that use Instructional Technologies. The committee is charged with working together to coordinate instructional technology needs, identify and solve problems, discuss new and emerging classroom tools, and ensure efficient use of the investment in Instructional Technology resources at Cayuga. The group also reviews Student Technology Fee Project Proposals in the spring of each year and makes recommendations for approval to the VP of Administration as per the defined criteria and process.
