



# FULL-TUITION Presidential Scholarships

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

First-time college students ranked in the top 20% of their high school classes (based on academic performance) from Cayuga and Oswego Counties. Recipients must be full-time and maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester to remain eligible. Students from Jordan-Elbridge, Red Creek, Skaneateles, Tyburn Academy and Union Springs Academy are also eligible.

## HOW TO APPLY

PLEASE COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS. Priority given to applications received by March 15:

- Admissions Application
- Official High School Transcript  
*(submitted directly from your school)*
- FAFSA (*Free Application for Federal Student Aid*)  
**Cayuga's FAFSA code: 002861**
- Completed TAP Application (*Tuition Assistance Program*)  
**Cayuga's TAP Code: 2005**

## AVAILABILITY

Given limited funds, eligible students may not receive an award.

## AMOUNTS AWARDED

NYS resident tuition less Pell, Tap and other Foundation scholarships; books and fees not included; up to four semesters at Cayuga. Incoming students who qualify as Presidential Scholars whose tuition and fees are fully funded by Pell and/or TAP are eligible to receive up to \$500 per semester through the Presidential Scholar Program.
