# **Information and Guidelines**

The Cayuga Bank Employee Memorial Scholarship is intended for eligible students who will be attending Cayuga Community College in Auburn, New York during the academic year following the spring semester in which they apply for consideration. One scholarship is awarded annually and is applicable for one year only. This is a competitive scholarship program, and the recipient is selected by a scholarship review committee of the college.

This scholarship is made possible, in part, through contributions made by employees and retirees of Cayuga Bank to The Cayuga County Community College Foundation.

Application forms are available from the Human Resources Department of First Niagara Bank and from the Financial Aid Office of Cayuga Community College. Applicants wishing to be considered for an award are asked to fill out a Cayuga Bank Employee Memorial Scholarship Program application and send it to:

Candidates are reminded that they must have also completed an application to, and have been accepted for, admission to Cayuga Community College.

#### **DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION**

The application deadline is May 1 of the year for which the candidate is applying. Applicants will be notified of the Scholarship Committee's decision by August 1.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for consideration applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be the child or grandchild of a current employee of First Niagara Bank\* or of a retiree of First Niagara Bank or Cayuga Bank whose effective date of retirement was on or after January 1, 1993.

\*Employed or formerly employed in the following offices: Former Cayuga Bank offices at Main, Grant Avenue, Loop Road,

West Genesee Street, Moravia, and Weedsport, and former Homestead Savings offices at Utica, Rome, Waterville, New Hartford, and Clinton.

- 2. Have achieved an academic average in high school of 75 or better, or in college, a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.
- 3. Give evidence of having participated in extra-curricular activities and/or community service activities and/or part-time work.
- 4. Have applied and been formally accepted to attend Cayuga Community College.
- 5. Have completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have submitted this information to the Financial Aid Office at Cayuga Community College.
- 6. Plan to attend college on a full-time basis for at least one year (12 credit hours or more per semester).
