PLEASE COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS BY MARCH 15:

- Admissions Application must be accepted by March 15
- Official High School Transcript (submitted directly from your school)
- Emerson Application/Personal Essay
- Letter of Recommendation (from teacher, counselor or employer)
- Current resume that details outstanding community involvement, leadership, service or commitment to employment
- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- Completed TAP Application (Tuition Assistance Program)
 Cayuga's TAP Code: 2005
