

First-time college students ranked in the top 20% of their high school classes (based on academic performance) from Cayuga and Oswego Counties. Recipients must be full-time and maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester to remain eligible. Students from Jordan-Elbridge, Red Creek, Skaneateles, Tyburn Academy and Union Springs Academy are also eligible.

## **AMOUNTS AWARDED**

NYS resident tuition less Pell, Tap and other Foundation scholarships; books and fees not included; up to four semesters at Cayuga. Incoming students who qualify as Presidential Scholars whose tuition and fees are fully funded by Pell and/or TAP are eligible to receive up to \$500 per semester through the Presidential Scholar Program.
