Student advised of the following:

- OTA Information Sessions held November-February—check website for specific dates—important to attend
- OTA Entrance Exam required—taken before April 15th application deadline; may only take entrance exam twice; To be eligible for acceptance into Cayuga’s OTA program, you must attain an overall score of “proficient” (65% or higher) on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Applicants with bachelor’s degree are exempt from entrance exam.
- OTA Application—available October 1<sup>st</sup> on website; due April 15th for admission for following Fall semester
- CPR—American Heart Association or Red Cross Certification good for 2 years; must have in-person skill testing
- Grade of C required for BIOL 203 and BIOL 204 and all OTA courses
- Cumulative GPA 2.5 required in order to progress to OTA 210 and OTA 211 (level II fieldwork courses)
- Must plan ahead to “save” courses if full-time status is desired once matriculated into OTA program
